Vanguard, State Street, Fidelity, and BlackRock control more than twenty percent of the votes of S&P 500 companies-Apollo, Blackstone, Carlyle and KKR, \$2.7 trillion of assets, and are eroding the legitimacy and accountability of American capitalism, not by controlling public companies, but by taking them over entirely, and removing them from public discourse and public scrutiny.
